Its great to see the Neighbourhood Team at your meetings and on patrol. We are making a genuine effort to be on your local areas with updates on social media so you can follow where we have been. Our priorities have been renewed this month with continued commitment to rural crime and the central area of West Bridgford. That's not to say we don't look at all issues on each area every day, we do. Every day I review what's been happening so that I can identify any patterns or trends and react to them quickly. We did this recently in Ruddington after an increase in auto crime with extra overnight patrols reducing the offending. Following an increase in reports, the Off Road Motorbike Team deployed to Rushcliffe with further patrols planned. Hopefully you have seen the recent post on social media showing a seized off road motorbike. Could you please reenforce caution about buying these motorbikes and electric scooters as well as the need for them to comply with Road Traffic Legislation if ridden or used on roads. They fall under the same Road Traffic law for license/insurance and drink and drug driving.

I am grateful for the support of Councillor Rob Inglis for his commitment to speeding, which the Reacher Team continue to do.

The increase of auto crime in Ruddington is now decreasing but could I ask that you encourage vehicle and home security. These offences will often be opportunistic and will target vehicles that are insecure or where there are personal belongings on show, a theme when I review crime data.
