Joseph Rodgers Brewitt

Joseph Rodgers Brewitt was born in East Bridgford in late 1897, the eldest son of James William and Elizabeth Brewitt, nee Rodgers.

In 1911 he was aged 13 years, still at school and living at Holme Lane with his parents and 5 younger siblings.

He enlisted with the 8th Battalion Sherwood Foresters, served in France in 1915 and was discharged in March 1919.

He married Rebecca Naylor aged 22 years in Newark in the summer of 1919 and they had seven children: Eric in 1920, Violet in 1921, Albert in 1923, John in 1927, Gladys 1928, Wilfred in 1932 and Margaret in 1932.

In August 1928 Joseph Brewitt was listed as living at 2, Edmond Road Newark and employed as a maltster.

We have been unable to find out any further information about Joseph Rodgers Brewitt.
