Trent Link Green Infrastructure Master Plan

This event presents the Trent Link Green Infrastructure Master Plan proposals. The proposals are the result of the River Trent to Cotgrave Green Infrastructure Study, which was commissioned by the Grantham Canal Partnership to look at the creation of a Green Infrastructure landscape corridor between the River Trent and Cotgrave Country Park. Key features of the Master Plan include:

- a navigable link between the Grantham Canal and the River Trent;
- new multi-user routes for use by pedestrians, cyclists and/or horseriders, including use of the disused mineral railway line;
- enhanced links between Cotgrave and Holme Pierrepont County Park;
- and a canal boat marina at Cotgrave Country Park.

The event will take the form of a presentation followed by the opportunity for members of the public to ask questions and view plans.
