On Saturday 13th March 2010 Nottingham Crown Court will be opening its doors for all to see the wheels of Justice in motion.

Supported by the partners of Nottinghamshire Criminal Justice Board, the court, located at 60 Canal Street, Nottingham, will be open from 11 am to 4pm. Events and activities, including mock sentencing exercises, presentations by partner agencies on subjects such as community sentencing, the chance to visit court cells and the opportunity to find out more about the Criminal Justice System, are organised to show members of the public, local communities, the media and any other interested parties how justice is done in our police stations, courts and prisons. There will be approximately 30 display stands, providing a range of information about the criminal justice system and other key organisations.

The open day follows on from the success of the 2008 events at Derby Combined Court and Nottingham Magistrates' Court. Approximately 1000 visitors attended each of these events and it is envisaged that this year's event will prove as popular.

The event is free of charge, open to all, and aims to provide a real insight into the criminal justice system and dispel some of the sentencing myths to those who may otherwise never come into contact with the criminal justice system
